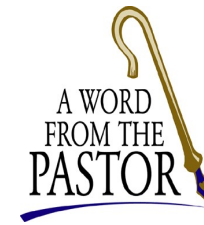

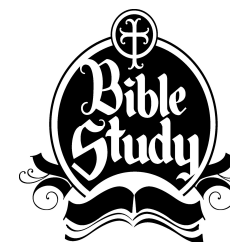

Tuesday evening Adoration at St. Gregory

One important tradition of our Catholic faith is a type of prayer often referred to as Eucharistic Adoration. In Adoration, the Blessed Sacrament is removed by a priest or deacon from the tabernacle and exposed for a time of contemplation and personal and communal prayer. Here at St. Gregory's we have offered Eucharistic adoration the first Friday morning of each month. To make this more available, we are moving this to Tuesday evenings. Each week, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed at 6:00 pm prior to our Tuesday evening Mass. (Confessions will continue to be offered during this time.)

To mark the Year of Mercy we will begin this time of prayer with some of St. Faustina's prayers to the Divine Mercy.
