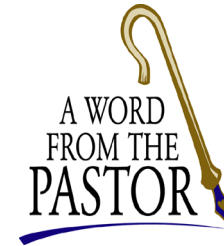

The resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead is the heart of our Christian faith.

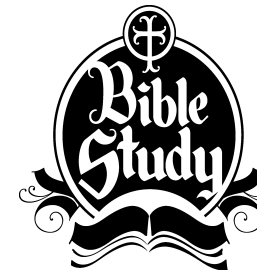
It is a sign to us that the final victory over sin and death has been won, and a reminder of our Lord's passionate desire that, like the good thief, we will one day be with him in paradise.
