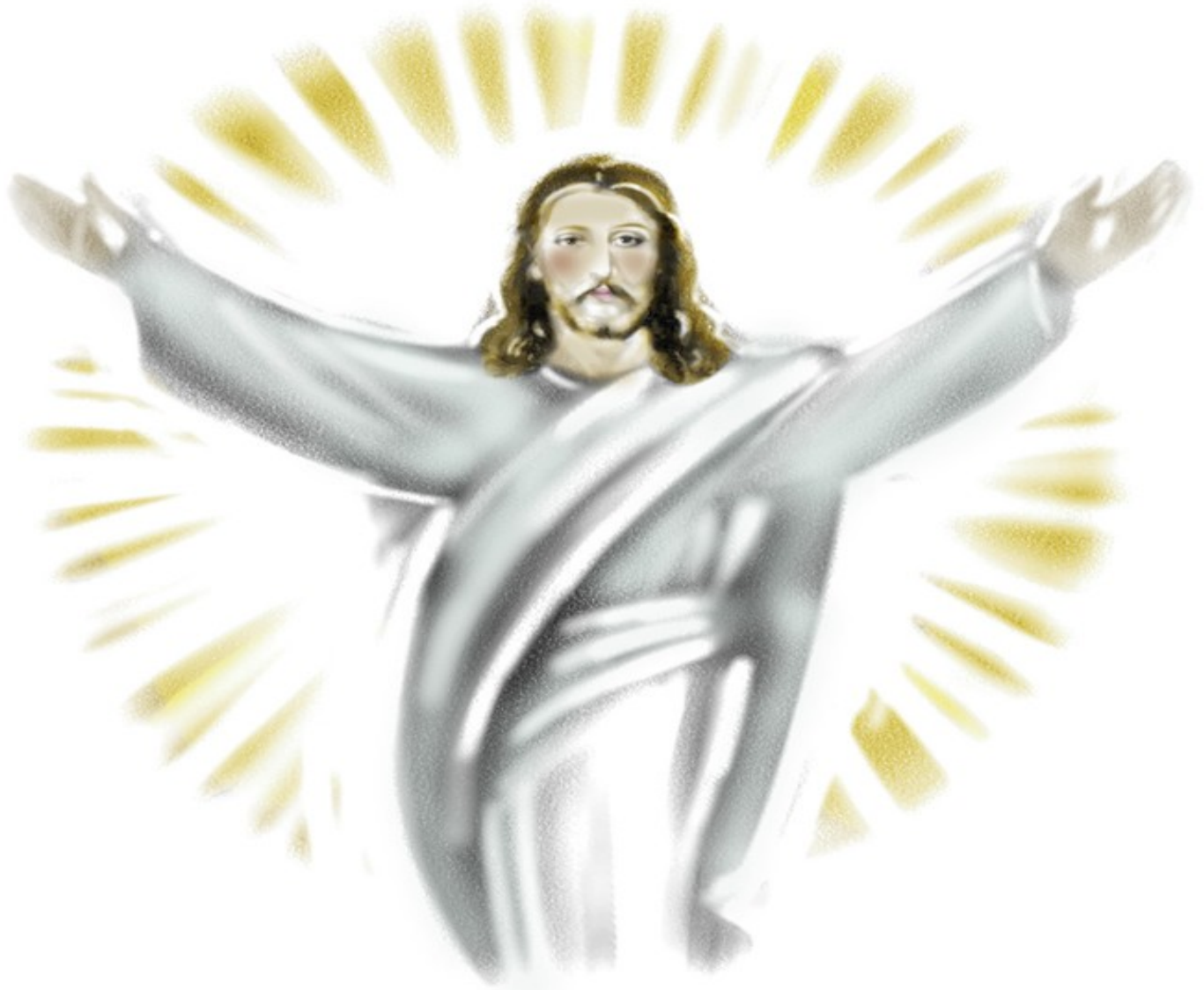

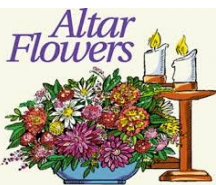
Easter Prayer
