Today on this wonderful feast, may each of us be fed, nourished and healed through the Body and Blood of Christ.

Reflection:

"While they were eating, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is my body.' Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, 'This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many.'"

Christi Sunday or Corpus Christi (Body and Blood of Christ) is a Eucharistic solemnity, the solemn commemoration of the institution of that sacrament. It is the Church's official act of homage and gratitude to Christ.

Jesus is shown many times in the gospels with his followers eating and drinking. They are hungry and so he feeds them not only with food but at a much deeper level. He teaches them, he welcomes them and he heals them. He treats us the same way; when we gather to celebrate the Eucharist, God's greatest gift to us, his body and blood.

But it is not our right and we cannot demand it. Pope Francis reminds us of this when he says, 'the Eucharist is not a prize for the perfect, but a powerful medicine and nourishment for the weak.'That's all of us and each of us!

Today, we are called to remember that we are the Body of Christ, the Church. As St. Paul reminds us, 'Now Christ's body is yourselves, and each of you with a part to play in the whole.' (1 Cor. 12.27). We are reminded that we are the living Church, the Body of Christ, whose head is Jesus himself. Through our communion with Jesus and each other we are called to be living stones making a spiritual house. At the end of every celebration of the Eucharist we are sent out with this great prayer of mission, *let us go now to love and serve the Lord.* If we share in the gift of Jesus' Body and Blood, then we are also asked to share this with others when leave church.

The usual symbol for the Holy Eucharist is a chalice, with a host rising out of it.
