Region of Waterloo Council adopts mask by-laws

“The Region will continue to take an education-first approach, asking people to comply with the by-laws and educating them on the importance of protecting each other. Face coverings are required in the following locations:

- Buses, bus shelters, ION trains, and ION platforms
- Stores and shopping malls
- Indoor areas of restaurants and bars, with the exception of patrons consuming food/drink
- Professional services such as counselling, personal care, funeral homes, repair, & rental services
- Lobby areas of commercial buildings
- Hotels & motels, exception of rented rooms
- Laundromats
- Indoor areas of fitness centres, gyms, & recreational and sports facilities
- Indoor concert venues, theatres, and cinemas
- Arcades and other indoor amusement facilities
- Museums, galleries, historic sites, etc.
- Places of worship**
- Municipal buildings
