"The Region will continue to take an education-first approach, asking people to comply with the by-laws and educating them on the importance of protecting each other. Face coverings are required in the following locations:

- •Buses, bus shelters, ION trains, and ION platforms
- •Stores and shopping malls
- •Indoor areas of restaurants and bars, with the exception of patrons consuming food/drink
- •Professional services such as counselling, personal care, funeral homes, repair, & rental services
- •Lobby areas of commercial buildings
- •Hotels & motels, exception of rented rooms
- •Laundromats
- •Indoor areas of fitness centres, gyms, & recreational and sports facilities
- •Indoor concert venues, theatres, and cinemas
- Arcades and other indoor amusement facilities
- •Museums, galleries, historic sites, etc.
- •Places of worship
- Municipal buildings
