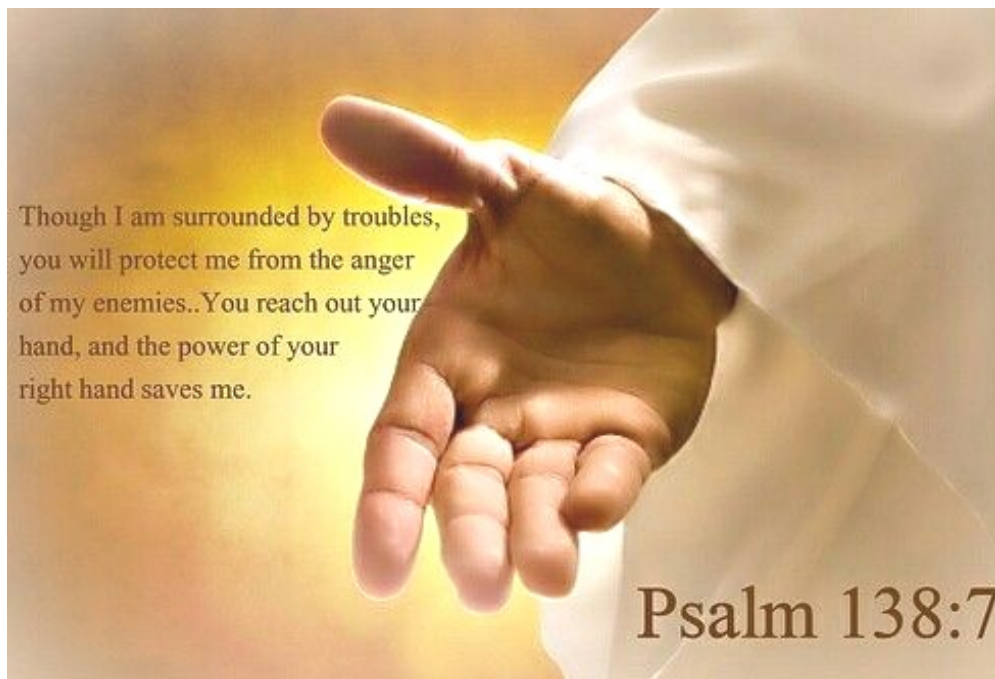

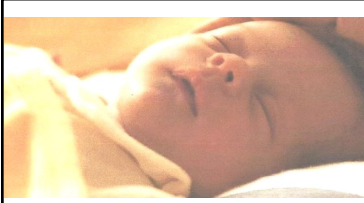
ROSARY PROCESSION
