40 Days to Grace and Glory —This Lent

We invite you to journey with Dr. Tim Gray by signing up for Daily Lenten Reflections. Each day you will receive in your inbox a short video which features Dr. Gray commenting on the daily Mass readings, explaining the Scriptures, and providing you with concrete ideas on how to apply them to your life.

Everyone is familiar with the story: the boat at sea, the terrible storm, fear gripping the disciples... Jesus, awakening from his sleep, taming the waves—and rebuking his friends for not having trusted he would care for them.

These men were accustomed to be out in all sorts of weather, so the storm had to be significant for them to be afraid. We're reminded that even in situations we perceive as dire—illness, financial distress, painful relationships—Christ will not let us drown. When the waters of life looms over us, he is there in the boat by our side.

Glorious Archangel Saint Raphael, great prince of the heavenly court, you are illustrious for your gifts of wisdom and grace.

You are a guide of those who journey by land or sea or air, consoler of the afflicted, and refuge of sinners. I beg you, assist me in all my needs and in all the sufferings of this life, as once you helped the young Tobias on his travels.

Because you are the medicine of God, I humbly pray to you to heal the many infirmities of my soul and the ills that afflict my body. I especially ask of you the favour (mention your request here) and the great grace of purity to prepare me to be the temple of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Lent—A Time for True Prayer

But when you pray, go to your inner room, close the door, and pray to your Father in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will repay you. [Matthew 6:6](#)

One of the most important parts of true prayer is that it takes place deep in the inner room of your soul. Saint Teresa of Ávila, describes the soul as a castle in which God dwells. Meeting Him, praying to Him and communing with Him requires that we enter into the deepest and innermost chamber within this castle of our soul. It is there, in the innermost dwelling, that the full glory and beauty of God is discovered. God is not just "out there" far away in Heaven. He is a God Who is closer and more intimate than we could ever imagine. Lent is a time, more than any other time of the year, when we must strive to make that journey inward to discover the in dwelling of the Most Holy Trinity.

What does God want of you this Lent? It's easy to begin Lent with more superficial commitments, such as giving up a favorite food, doing extra good deeds, getting more exercise, more spiritual readings, etc. All of this is good and useful. But you can be sure that the deepest desire of our Lord for you this Lent is that you pray.

Prayer, is much more than saying prayers. Prayer is ultimately a relationship with God. It's an encounter with the Triune God Who dwells within you. True prayer is an act of love between you and your Beloved. It's an exchange of persons: your life for God's. Prayer is an act of union and communion by which we become one with God and God becomes one with us.
