



Pope Francis announced the establishment of the first World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly taking place on Sunday, July 25th with a theme "I am with your always". This date coincides with the feast of Sts. Joachim and Anne, Jesus' grandparents. "Their voice is precious because it sings the praises of God and safeguards the roots of peoples. They remind us that old age is a gift and that grandparents are the link between generations, passing on the experience of life and faith to the young. Grandparents are often forgotten and we forget this wealth of preserving roots and passing on." He said. Cardinal Kevin J. Farrell, prefect of the Dicastery for Laity, the Family and Life, sees the yearly event as "a gift to the whole church" since it stresses the importance of the pastoral care of the elderly as "a priority that can no longer be postponed by any Christian community." Many of our elderly live alone and are often lonely; this is our chance to let them know they matter to the Church and the community.
