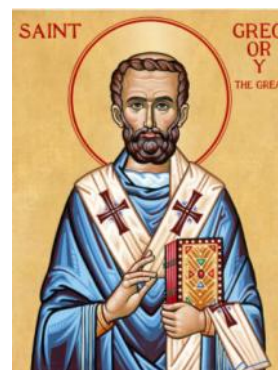
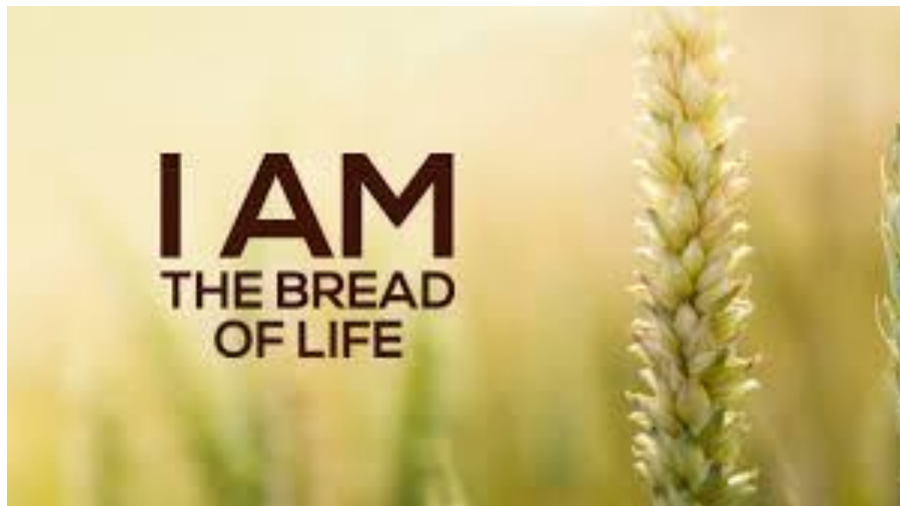

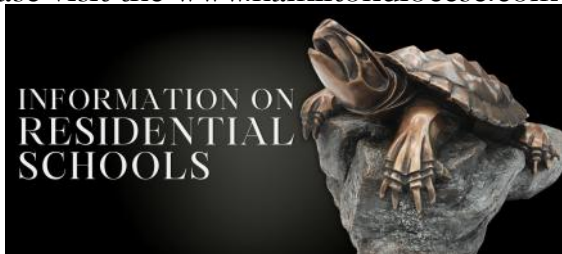

What do you believe your mission in this world is? As Catholics have long believed, by receiving the Body and Blood of Christ in the Holy Eucharist we are changed, transformed, as we welcome God to enter and work within us. This inner transformation is for our mission in the world. "Having shared in the sacramental communion, we are sent forth, as Christ's body, to be broken, poured out [and] consumed... Now our flesh, minds and hearts are on the line, offered through, with and in Christ as feast for the world's hungers" writes renown liturgical author and catechist, Bernadette Gasslein (*Living with Christ*, August issue, p. 63).

The faith required of us in this process of inner transformation is no small matter. This month's feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (August 15) invites us to contemplate the deep mystery of Mary's own faith as she responded to God's call, as challenging as it was, to become the Mother of God. The feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord (August 6) recalls the miraculous way in which Jesus revealed his divinity on Mount Tabor, thereby reminding us that all things are truly possible with God.
