

This Sunday's readings joyfully proclaim that "The LORD, your God, *is in your midst*, a mighty savior." And the Psalm exclaims, "Shout with exultation, O city of Zion, for great *in your midst* is the Holy One of Israel." St. Paul writes to the Philippians that "The Lord is near." And finally, John the Baptist assures us of the immanence of Jesus' coming, saying "one mightier than I *is coming.*"

We try our best to mask our fragility in life, but, like Israel, we are surrounded by enemies. The world is full of dangers we try to ignore. Our own minds produce wolves of self-doubt, anxiety, and resentments to contend with. It seems easiest to try to co-exist with the wolves as long as possible. But Jesus says, I am here. I bring victory. I bring healing. Do not be afraid. This Advent, we can stop trying to fight the wolves ourselves. Our time on earth is full of wolves—inside our minds and in the world. The promise of Christmas is that Jesus runs into our clearing. He is in our midst! During Advent, we wait as he runs to bring new victory and peace to our lives.


