

What are you doing for Lent?

Attend Mass - weekday or weekend Go to confession Thank God always for your life/family/friends Pray—prayers helps revive your soul Read from the Holy Bible (Mathew, Mark, James..) Abstain from a bad habit Don't buy anything that you don't need No Gossiping No negative thinking or negative self talk

March 13, 2022

We have read that Jesus was tempted to use his authority to make bread. This first temptation is not just a temptation for physical comfort. But it is a temptation for him to use his authority over all creation for himself instead of for the Kingdom of God.

The second temptation is for worldly kingship and the type of kingdom where those with little serve the king for his own benefit. Jesus resists this kingship, for the Kingdom of God, which will eventually lead to the cross.

The third temptation is to use the power of God for his own glory. This power is meant to be used for his mission, which Satan seeks to disrupt.

Jesus resists these temptations to use his authority, kingship, and power for himself. Instead he remains focused on his mission.

As we start our journey through Lent, our Sunday readings call us to adopt the same confidence that Jesus had in the face of temptation: God's word alone will suffice; God's promise of protection can be trusted; God alone is God.

Reflection Questions: Do I use the gifts I have been given for myself or for the Kingdom of God? What tempts me the most: comfort, the esteem of others, or power?

How can I use this Lent to be more like Jesus?
