

St. Paul's Center:

Reflect on the Three Pillars of Lent

In the Gospel reading, that same Jesus Christ invites and challenges each one of us to embrace the Christian ideal, by almsgiving, prayer, and fasting — the three pillars of Lent.

The key to unlocking this Gospel lies in the first reading: "Tear your hearts, and not your garments.." (Joel 2:13). This is the interpretive key which beats like a quiet but continuous drumbeat throughout the entire Old Testament. The whole law, the prophets, the Incarnation, and the Cross, our almsgiving, our prayer, our fasting—all of these are ultimately about one thing: allowing God to win over our hearts.

Just as the Israelites were forced to wander in the desert for forty years, and just as Jesus went out for forty days before beginning His ministry, so too we should see these next forty days as an occasion for enormous spiritual growth. Let us pray for the grace to have our hearts purified, renewed, and set afire in Lent.

Returning the Love: For every act of mercy, love, forgiveness and care, we receive the same. Luke6:36-38
