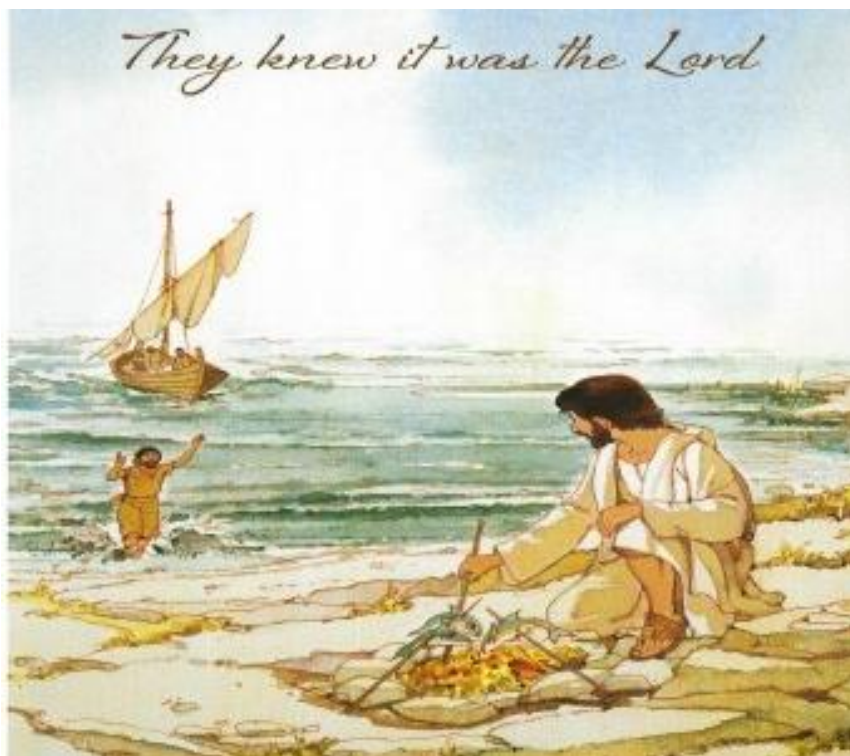

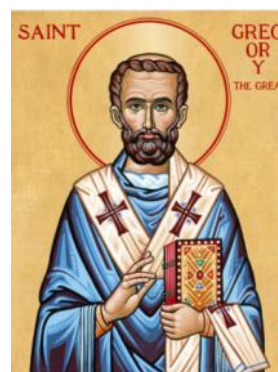

May 1, 2022

Jesus chose an unlikely bunch to be His apostles. From a human point of view, they were a collection of faults and weaknesses, among them cowardice, thick-headedness and ambition. But that was the point: these were the individuals Jesus wanted — real, ordinary people. He not only could see the fish lurking below the surface of the water, but He could also see into human hearts and souls.

He told the fishermen to put their nets on the right side of the boat. They made a huge haul of fish, almost too much for their nets. Fishing nets are a symbol for end-time activity, the drawing in of all souls to God. This would be the work of Peter and the other apostles. Jesus was well aware of Peter’s weaknesses, but He was also aware of his humility in recognizing his need for God’s grace. Those who are humble and open to change and transformation are the most effective tools in God’s hands. Peter and the others would draw many to God in their fishing for souls, and we are the ones whom God has designated to continue their work.
