

As we continue in the Season of Easter.

We have heard about how the pandemic and its restrictions caused division and rift in families, our parish communities and in our homes. We can use the Easter celebration to encourage us to heal our personal rifts and divisions and to bring about peace. healing and a new beginning.

So, what is the spiritual significance of Easter in our own lives? The celebration of the resurrection of Jesus from death speaks to us of the triumph of life over death. This year Easter was celebrated in the midst of wars with the increasing number of refugees and the lack of respect for human dignity. How do we celebrate Easter in the midst of human tragedy? As baptized people we not only celebrate the glorious event of Easter, we live that event in our lives. In his encyclical letter Fratelli Tutti, Pope Francis writes, "Love, then, is more than just a series of benevolent actions. Those actions have their source in a union increasingly directed towards others considering them of value, worthy, pleasing and beautiful apart from their physical or moral appearances. Our love for others, for who they are moves us to see the best of their lives."

On the day of the Resurrection the Gospel of John's story of Mary Magdalene, Peter and John inspires us all. Their joy and enthusiasm of being sent by the Risen Lord to spread the good news of the Resurrection encourages us to share the good news. The Easter event is not a one-time event. It is a journey that continues after our great celebration of Easter Sunday. As we joyfully sing the Easter Alleluia, let our celebration inspire us to live so that our lives may shine with light and love.
