

On July 24, 2022 we will celebrate the second World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. Pope Francis' goal of creating this yearly world day was to bring attention to our need to care for our elderly. This date coincides with the feast of Sts. Joachim and Anne, Jesus' grandparents.

"Their voice is precious because it sings the praises of God and safeguards the roots of peoples. They remind us that old age is a gift and that grandparents are the link between generations, passing on the experience of life and faith to the young. Grandparents are often forgotten and we forget this wealth of preserving roots and passing on." said Cardinal Kevin J. Farrell, prefect of the Dicastery for Laity, the Family and Life. He sees this event as "a gift to the whole church" since it stresses the importance of the pastoral care of the elderly as "a priority that can no longer be postponed by any Christian community." Many of our elderly live alone and are often lonely; this is our chance to let them know they matter to the Church and the community.
