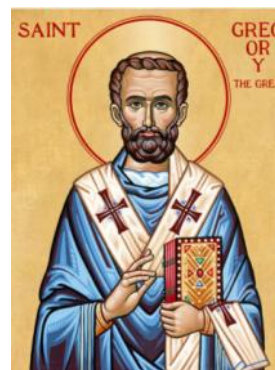

November 13th, 2022

During the month of November, the Church prays in a special way for those who have died. But praying for the dead may prompt questions. Aren't the dead already with God and beyond our prayers?

It's an important question—and one Msgr. J. Brian Bransfield explores in his book [Life Everlasting: The Mystery and the Promise](#) as he narrates his own experience of tragedy and loss:

Human frailty is not a fantasy. It is a daily and often hourly reality.... Dozens of times a day we react hurriedly with impatience, self-centeredness, and a quick temper. If we retain these imperfections at the moment of death, we do not merit the penalty of eternal separation from God, but neither are we ready to enter heaven.... What is the fate of the person who has not, through his or her actions, rejected the Lord through unrepentant mortal sin, but who is nonetheless attached to sin in some way at the moment of death?

For such persons God lovingly provides a means to enter his presence. Purgatory is the intermediary state of perfection after death in which these souls are cleansed of non mortal sins, healed, and made ready to see God.... This does not mean that God is strict, severe, or cruel, but instead reveals a new dimension of his abiding mercy. God makes them ready so that their joy and happiness on seeing him may be full from its very first moment.... Our prayer for the dead is a palpable and effective sign of our bond with them, so that they may more quickly be purified and enter the bliss of heaven.

As we pray and offer Masses for our departed loved ones this month, may God's purifying love prepare them—and us—more fully for our ultimate destination: Life Everlasting in Him.


