

Season of Lent Journey of Penance What is Lent?

Lent is a yearly celebration of the Church in preparation for Easter. *Lent has two major purposes:* It recalls or prepares for Baptism, and emphasizes a spirit of penance. Through forty days of closer attention to God's Word and of more fervent prayer, we are prepared to celebrate the Paschal Mystery. During Lent, the reminder of baptism already received, as well as the theme of repentance, renew the entire community.

Lent is a privileged time for *prayer, fasting and almsgiving*. By giving us opportunity to renew and deepen our relationship with Jesus, renew the choices we make, so that we might live as he taught. The forty days represents the time Jesus spent in the wilderness, enduring the temptation of Satan and preparing to begin his ministry.

Lenten Penance and the Synodal Journey

Pope Francis reminds us Lenten penance is a commitment, sustained by grace, to overcoming our lack of faith and our resistance to following Jesus on the way of the cross."

"May the Holy Spirit inspire and sustain us this Lent in our ascent with Jesus, so that we may experience his divine splendour and thus, confirmed in faith, persevere in our journey together with him, glory of his people and light of the nations."
