

This is my beloved Son. Listen to him. (Mark 9:7)

There are so many voices in our lives. All the people, situations, and messages that clamor for our attention, how do we hear and follow the voice of Jesus? Lent is a sacred time for learning to listen to God who speaks to us through Scripture, daily prayer, Mass and the sacraments, and the people & moments that make up our life. Preparing for the Sacrament of Reconciliation during Lent also gives us a special opportunity to listen for God's call to greater freedom.

"Though often in the beginning stages of going to confession we produce lists of things we have done wrong, in time it can give way to a conversation with Jesus about what he desires of us. Questions such as: Where have I felt a desire for something more in my life? What have I felt moved to do for others in ways that are out of the ordinary scope of my behavior? Has a movie or song or book struck me deeply with a realization about myself or others? ...

Confession can be a consistent stepping-stone to personal transformation if we ask: What is God doing in my life? What am I doing that 'seconds' his action, and what in me is resisting his invitation? Bringing this to Jesus in confession strengthens, clarifies, and opens up the way before us."

When we recognize and confess the times we failed to listen to Jesus, we hear him speak to us again with great love and deep joy in the Sacrament of Reconciliation: *I absolve you from your sins*.
