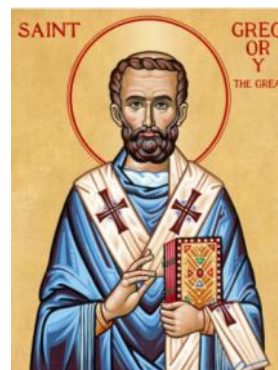

Does your life feel like it is running in three, or five, or twenty different directions at once? Are you in agony over a difficult decision or worried about a loved one? In these situations, and so many more, how do we find rest?

Saint Elizabeth of the Trinity can help. Born July 18, 1880, she was a French Carmelite nun who, by all external appearances, lived a quieter life than most of us. But through her vocation to a cloistered life of prayer, God taught her—and us—how to recollect ourselves and keep our lives pointing toward Him, even amid difficulty, darkness, or chaos.

"It seems to me," Elizabeth wrote, "that keeping one's strength for the Lord is to unify one's whole being through interior silence. It is to gather all our powers in order to put them solely toward the exercise of love." Love unifies us. In frantic, stressful, or sorrowful moments, we can remember that God is holding us in existence, and we can focus all our strength on loving him back. This gaze of love is not easy—but it helped her face life with greater freedom, peace, and zeal. Today, notice your desires and movements of the heart. When feelings like fear, anxiety, selfishness, or jealousy choke your ability to love God and others, stop and silently surrender them to God. Ask God to heal your heart until it is moved by only one thing: *love.* In Christ, *Daughters of St. Paul*
