


January 21, 2024

This Sunday-the Church celebrates the Sunday of the Word of God. The feast begs the question: what is the word of God? How do we hear it? And more importantly, how do we live it?

When God speaks, he creates. In Genesis, we read that God spoke the world into being. "Let there be light," God declared—and there was light. Saint Paul affirms, from his own experience, that "the word of God is alive and active." God's word is not merely an idea, but a living reality: the self-revelation of God. The Word is Jesus Christ himself.

In a moment of prayer, Father Gaston Courtois perceived Jesus's invitation to listen more intensely to him, the living Word:

I am the Verbum silens ("silent Word"), but I penetrate your mind with my ideas. If you are attentive, if you are recollected, my love will dispel the shadows in your thoughts and can then translate into words what I want to make known to you. When you hear the word of God proclaimed at Mass or read the scriptures on your own, do you let this word "create" you? Do you give the Word permission to shape your thoughts and actions? Do you reflect the Word in your life, allowing it to "take flesh" in you? The next time you meet God in scripture, ask Jesus to make you attentive to his way of thinking, speaking, and loving: to "dispel the shadows in your thoughts," and replace them with his own.
