

- Attend stations of the Cross (Fridays at 7pm). Reflect on the Stations of the Cross as a way to journey through Lent
- Good Samaritan Bags .. Get reusable bags and pack them with healthy snacks, toiletries, socks, and other helpful items. Keep them in your car, make it a goal to hand them out to people in need


