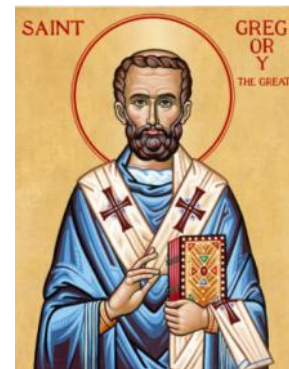

Reflection: Love as Obedience to God's Word

At the heart of the Gospel this Sunday lies Jesus' profound teaching that authentic **love** is expressed through obedience to God's word. This is not about burdensome rule-following but is a natural response to **divine love**. When Jesus says, "Whoever loves me will keep my word," he establishes that our actions reveal the true nature of our **love**; we cannot claim to love God while disregarding his teachings and commands.

This obedience isn't meant to be grudging compliance but a joyful alignment of our will with God's, recognizing that his commands are designed for our flourishing and the well-being of the community. It's about **loving one another** as Jesus has loved us, which helps us navigate the complexities of human relationships with wisdom, patience, and sacrificial **love**.

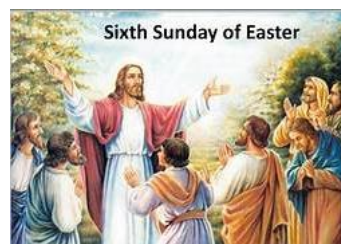
