

### June 8, 2025

Reflection: At Christmas, God became incarnate: He came to share with us His participation in the divine life and in the grace of God. Easter is the feast of the resurrection of the soul from sin and of the incorporation of man in the mystical body of the Eucharist. Pentecost is the feast of the visible mission of the Holy Spirit to the apostles, to the Church and to each of us. By virtue of His death on the cross, the Lord has merited the grace of the sending of the Holy Spirit. Now that He is in heaven He prays for and effects the coming of the Holy Spirit, that we may grow in grace and holiness, that we may be strong and firm in faith, that we may reach perfection and share in the inheritance of Christ.

The feast of Pentecost is a day of thanksgiving for the foundation of the Church. Pentecost is a day of thanksgiving for the coming of the Holy Spirit and for the establishment of the sacrament of confirmation. It is a day on which we place a joyful and grateful trust in the Holy Spirit within us, and thank Him for His inspiration and guidance. On this day we again place ourselves in the hands of the Holy Spirit with complete confidence. He should be the soul of our souls; He should reign in us, amid the ruins of our own fallen nature. Pentecost is a day of petition, a day on which we should implore the Holy Spirit for a full measure of His graces and gifts.

Join us in our First **Eucharist Procession** after Mass on June 22, 2025 around St. Gregory's church. The Eucharist is the source and summit of the whole Christian

life. A Eucharistic procession, is a public witness of the veneration toward the most holy Eucharist, conducted through public streets. It takes place in this way: A consecrated host - that is, the real and substantial presence of Jesus Christ: body, blood, soul and divinity - is placed within a monstrance, which is then lifted and carried by a priest who leads the faithful in procession. Like a pilgrimage, a Eucharistic procession is a reminder to the Catholic faithful of their spiritual journey toward eternal life with God.

As Pope emeritus Benedict XVI noted in a homily, "It was born for the very precise purpose of openly reaffirming the faith of the people of God in Jesus Christ, alive and truly present in the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist. It is a feast that was established in order to publicly adore, praise and thank the Lord, who continues 'to love us to the end,' even to offering us his body and his blood." By processing with the Holy Eucharist we serve as witnesses to the intimate presence of God in the world and in each other. This powerful display of the Incarnation, or God becoming human speaks of his merciful love for all who journey to eternal life with him.
