

St. Gregory the Great (540—604)

Feast day Saturday, September 3rd

Patron of our parish, St. Gregory the Great was a mayor, a monk, a pope and a writer. Unhappy with his life as mayor of Rome, St. Gregory allocated half his fortune to the poor and the other half to the foundation of seven monasteries. After joining a monastery in pursuit of a simple life, he was elected to the papacy. As pope, he cared for the poor, implemented the Gregorian reforms to improve Church governance and clerical behavior, promoted the monastic vocation, and renewed the liturgy. His name is associated with Gregorian chant (plainsong) and Eucharistic Prayer II (along with St. Hippolytus). A prolific writer and Doctor of the Church, St. Gregory composed numerous theological texts and is cited 374 times in St. Thomas Aquinas' Summa Theologiae.

St. Gregory the Great Pray for us!

The Sunday's Gospel is about making real choices in following Jesus. Being His disciple takes commitment. It means putting Him first, even when it is hard. Jesus asks us to think carefully about what it means to follow Him. Faith is not just words or feelings. It asks for action, trust, and sacrifice.

The readings show that we need God's help to live this way. Our own understanding is not enough. We need His wisdom to guide us.

Following Jesus also changes how we treat others. We are called to love and welcome everyone as part of God's family.

The challenge for us is to look at our priorities and ask if we are ready to live for Christ above everything else.
