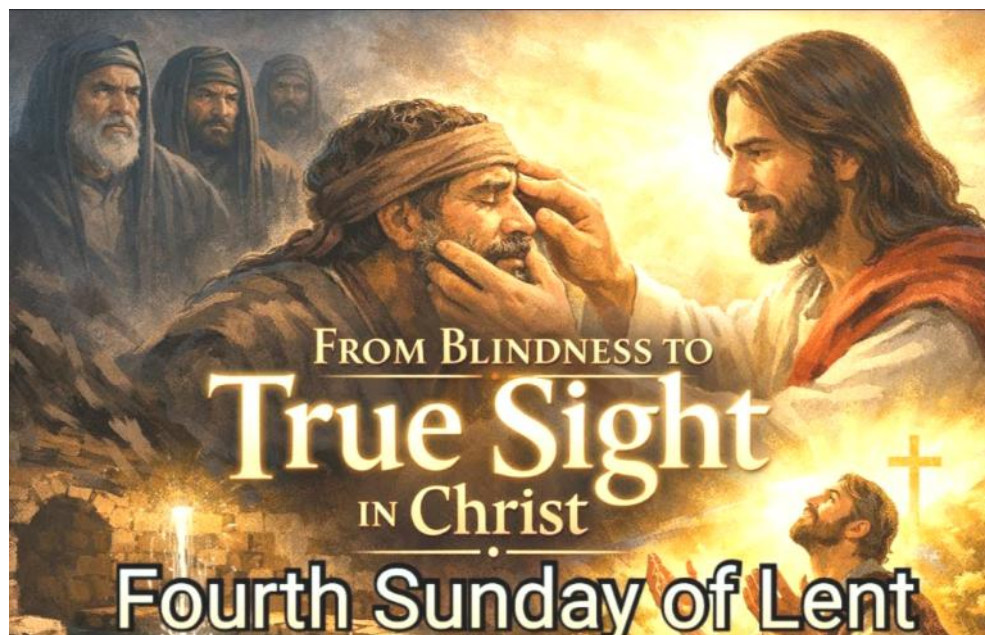

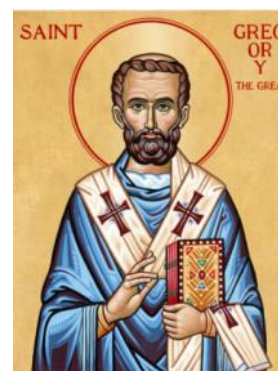

Reflection: This month we find ourselves well into the season of Lent. What are our goals for this Lent? Do we wish to be transformed by God's grace? Do we wish to be changed? This month's Gospels are about God's ability and power to bring new life. First, we meet the Samaritan woman at the well – someone who for the longest time was searching for love and fulfillment and finally found it in Jesus! Then, we meet a man who was blind from birth but receives a miracle of sight from Jesus – not only physical sight but spiritual sight as well, when he realizes Jesus' true identity. Finally, we read of the raising of Lazarus from the dead a second chance at life!

The Gospels of the Samaritan woman, the man born blind, the raising of Lazarus – all of these touch upon, in one way or another, our own need for Jesus to become *our living water, our light, our new life.*

Are there areas of our lives that we have long given up on and accepted as "dead"?

This Lent, are we willing to gather the courage to entrust our hopeless situations to God, not only to see his glory, but to receive the grace that gives us a fresh, new start?

May God bless us as we seek him with a renewed faith this Lent!
