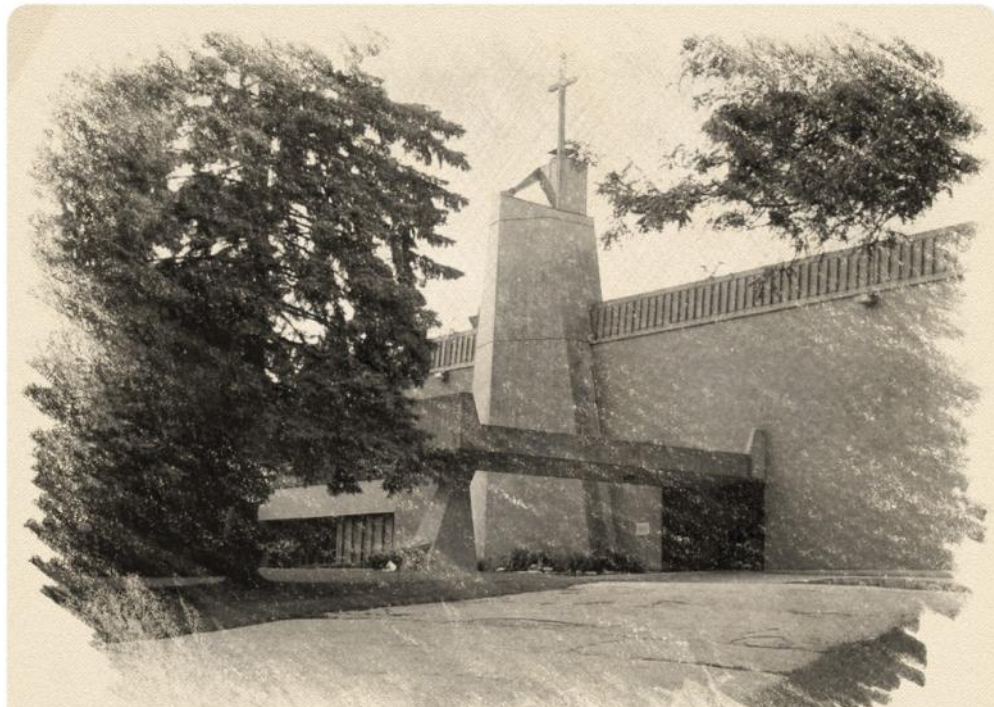

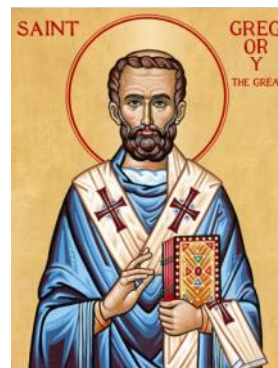

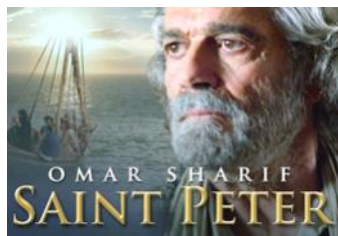

Thought; Do you find joy in challenges from others? You should. Notice the athlete. He works out every day disciplining his body with hard training because he knows this will make him stronger for the battle and the purpose for victory. You are working out every day, whether you know it or not. There is a spiritual battle for your soul at every second without rest. If you face problems like Jesus, with an iron will, the absolute determination to conquer sin and death, then you are in control of your pain and sufferings, knowing that they make you stronger and a better version of yourself. And finally have something worthy to offer God. "I know your works, your labor, and your endurance, and that you cannot tolerate the wicked; you have tested those who call themselves "apostles" but are not, and discovered that they are impostors. Moreover, you have endurance and have suffered for My Name, and you have not grown weary."

Challenges make you realize that you're not getting worn down by them - but instead you are getting stronger and more powerful in different ways. You are able to endure because by faith, you realize that only good transforms the one who does the will and works of God.

"Just as our breath is the life of our body, so also the one Spirit of God enlivens the one Body of Christ. Our lives are not our own, though. We live to pour them out in service to God and neighbour, as Christ pours out His life to bring us to life in the water of Baptism and the lifeblood of the Eucharist. Let us serve the needs of Christ's Body in others with all of our gifts for the praise and glory of God." He gave you the gift of endurance and He also gave you the gift to suffer well. Don't sell yourself short. "Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us EXERCISE them." (Rom 12:6a)
